

BARRY MILLER:

Barry Miller, Principal (ASLA, PLA), was born and raised in Miami, Florida. Barry attended the University of Florida, beginning in Architecture and later changing his major to Landscape Architecture after being inspired by a film about the work of Frederick Law Olmsted. He received his Bachelor's Degree in Landscape Architecture in 1979. After working for three years at a landscape office in Miami, he returned to the University of Florida to get his Master of Urban & Regional Planning Degree in 1985, completing his thesis work on regional development in Jamaica. In 1982, he became a licensed Landscape Architect in the State of Florida and served as Miami Section Chairman of the American Society of Landscape Architects (ASLA) in the early 90s. Upon graduation, Barry worked at SWA Group, Wallace Roberts & Todd (WRT), and Bruce Howard & Associates, before forming Savino Miller Design Studio with Adriana Savino. He is currently a member of ASLA, TREEmendous Miami, and the North Miami Chamber of Commerce.
